
## P.M.G. Completes Big Haulage Job



Victorian P.M.G. transport officers completed their biggest haulage job yesterday when they took three big wooden aerial poles, pictured above, from Beaufort to Lyndhurst. Largest of the poles is 112 feet long and weighs nine tons. The others are 80 and 75 feet long. They will be used at the A.B.C. transmitting station at Lyndhurst, near Dandenong. The poles were taken through the city early yesterday to avoid traffic.
